

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the midst of this crazy-cold winter, it's always nice to have something to look forward to. While the thaw and warming of longer, sunny days is still a way off, there IS something we can look forward to, Valentine's Day! While some say that Valentine's Day is for kids or even a "made-up holiday" and an excuse for Hallmark and candy makers to increase profits, this year's Valentine's Day can take on a more special meaning for us as Christians, because it's also **Ash Wednesday**.

While at first glance, having Ash Wednesday on Valentine's Day might feel like a bit of a downer or even an oxymoron, we have planned a meaningful Ash Wednesday this year. The Outreach committee is planning a wonderful and warming Lasagna dinner and thanks to Pastor Roberto who will make the lasagnas (one meat and one veg), we know it will be delicious!

Then we will move into the sanctuary for a meaningful Ash Wednesday service which will include the imposition of ashes. While historically Presbyterians had felt that the imposition of ashes was a penitential rite only for our Catholic sisters and brothers, it is growing in popularity in Protestant churches and can be a very meaningful experience for all involved. The dinner will be at 6:30PM. Worship is at 7:30. I hope that you may be able to attend both. If you need a ride, please let me know.

Further, since Lent begins on Valentine's Day, our Lenten theme this year will be "Love: How to love God and others as God loves us". While this may seem cute or even shallow on the surface, Loving God and others can be a meaningful daily discipline, especially when God feels distant and/or our loved ones stress us or make us crazy!

To help us though our Lenten journey Pastor Roberto and I will also be leading a weekly Lenten Devotional Study throughout Lent, Wednesdays at 6:30 PM, which will also include Soup/bread. This year's devotional guide is <u>Jesus, Guide My Life</u> by Sr. Joyce Rupp. Rupp is a prolific author, and this is a daily devotional so even if you can't make the weekly study, you can follow along with her daily devotions, each day in Lent through to Easter. If you can only make a few of the Wednesday sessions, that works too because there are 6 readings to choose from each week. Pastor Roberto and I will also be preaching though some of the texts Rupp uses each Sunday in Lent. You can order the book through Amazon in print \$14 or Kindle for 10.50. If you need us to order you one, please let me know ASAP.

I hope and pray that this gives you all an approachable and meaningful roadmap for Lent and that you will be able to enjoy the journey in the company of one another, in love.

The meeting will continue every Wednesday of Lent until Holy Week.


Participation is free, but we ask that you sign up to participate so we can calculate how much soup to make.
